**STRUCTURE:**

- **MainStreet** fosters economic development in the state by supporting local MainStreet downtown revitalization, organizations. The Program provides resources, education, training and services that preserve local historic culture and heritage and stimulate the economic vitality of each participating community. *Contact Director Rich Williams*

  - Provides partnering opportunities by the state with Pueblos and Tribal Nations focusing on workforce development, infrastructure, information technology, identifying barriers to economic development, adapt existing EDD programs for tribes & pueblos, and create new EDD programs for tribes & pueblos

- **Enterprise Facilitation (Sirolli)**
  - Provides facilitation between entrepreneurs and capital investors to create business and jobs in Grant County, Luna County, Taos County.
