#### **Clean and Beautiful Funding Supports Three New Assets in Silver City**

The Town of Silver City received funding from the New Mexico Tourism Dept.'s <u>Clean and</u> <u>Beautiful Program</u> for three separate projects. The Town was one of 37 communities to receive funding last year to develop and enhance beautification and recycling initiatives!

• The Youth Mural Program installed the **tile mural** on the restroom building at the Main Street Plaza, in cooperation with <u>Silver City MainStreet</u>; the mural acknowledges the rare riparian habitat in Silver City and is colorful, beautiful, and interpretive.



• The Gila Native Plant Society made improvements to the **Silva Creek Botanical Garden**, including new plantings, a large pergola, plant signage and more.



• And Constructavision, LLC built a **parklet** on the corner of Yankie and Texas Streets, a beautiful place to sit and enjoy a cup of coffee downtown. The planter boxes have a mural designed by Jean Robert Beffort with native plants.

Silver City MainStreet served as the program coordinator for the Town, and they invite the public to see these new assets in the community!
